Dress Rehearsal

Dress rehearsal is on Saturday, June 10th in the morning.

9:45am - Students in Ballet 4 and 5 and WBC arrive

10:00am - Students in all other classes and backstage assistants arrive and sit in the theater with their class for the rehearsal and performance information; Ballet 4 and 5 and WBC warmup on stage

10:30am - all students will move backstage with backstage assistants; Ballet 4 and 5 and WBC mark through

11:00am - rehearsal starts

Approximately 1:30pm - rehearsal finishes

Rehearsal is not optional.

This is the only opportunity the students have to get the "feel" of the stage and performing area -- how the production will happen -- **before** the actual performance. This is crucial for the students so they will have an enjoyable concert experience.

Annual Concert Day

2:30pm - Students in Ballet 4 and 5 and WBC arrive

2:45pm - Backstage assistants arrive; Warmup on stage for students in Ballet 4 and 5 and WBC

3:00 p.m. – Theater opens and students in Ballet 1 and up, Tap 2 and up, Beginning Acrobatics and higher arrive for the concert; proceed to the backstage area

3:20pm - Ballet 3 student escorts meet on stage

3:30pm - all other students allowed backstage; they will be escorted to their groups by our Ballet 3 student escorts

3:45pm - All acrobatic students warmup on stage

4:00pm – Concert begins -- **ON TIME**

Approximately 6:00pm - Concert finishes; great job everyone!

Costumes

The costumes are rented from Ballet Academy. Each student will wear their own shoes but information about tights color, pants, etc. will be sent to each student in May.

All costumes are handled **ONLY** by the backstage mother. No costumes go home with individual students.

Backstage Assistants

A mother from each class is needed to stay with the children throughout both rehearsal and performance. The Backstage Mother is able to watch her child's performance from the stage wings. This person also handles the class costumes.

Any class without a Backstage Assistant will not be able to participate in the concert.

Beginning April 17, there will be a sign-up sheet for Backstage Mothers on the front counter in the Ballet Academy lobby.
